



ArtsVote in New Mexico

(Updated as of 7/17/22)

Ensure Your Vote is COUNTED on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 8, 2022

CONFIRM

Pre-Requisites

- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be a resident of New Mexico
- Be at least 18 years of age by Election Day, November 8, 2022
- Not legally declared mentally incapacitated
- Not a convicted felon, UNLESS you have completed the court-ordered sentence of imprisonment, including any term of parole or probation for the conviction

STEP 1

Register to Vote & Check Accuracy

Check the Accuracy of your [current voter registration](#) or **Register to Vote** for the first time [online](#) or [by mail](#). (NOTE: For online registration only, you will also need your social security number and driver's license or state ID number in order to complete the online form.) Both **mailed-in** and **online** registrations close **Tuesday, October 11, 2022**. However, you also have the option of **in-person** registration throughout Early Voting, which begins **Tuesday, October 11, 2022** and ends **Saturday, November 5, 2022** at [county clerk](#) offices. ***Don't delay, pledge to check the accuracy of your voter status or register to vote by Tuesday, September 20, 2022.***

STEP 2

Request Your Absentee Ballot (If Preferred)

In New Mexico, voting absentee **does not require an excuse**, but you must [apply for it](#) because it will **NOT** be sent to you automatically. You can [request an absentee ballot](#) through your [county clerk](#), by mail, by phone, or [online](#). All absentee ballot requests must be RECEIVED by **Tuesday, November 3, 2022**. ***If you choose to vote by Absentee Ballot, pledge to submit your Absentee Ballot request by Tuesday, October 18, 2022.***

STEP 3

Cast Your Vote

ABSENTEE BALLOTS: Completed Absentee bBallots must be RECEIVED by **Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022**, in order to be counted. You can sign up to [track your absentee ballot](#) on the New Mexico Secretary of State website. Absentee ballots begin being counted on **Election Day**. ***Don't delay, if you choose to vote by Absentee Ballot, pledge to mail-in your completed Absentee Ballot by Tuesday, October 18, 2022.***

- OR -

IN-PERSON VOTING: You may vote early in New Mexico at your [county clerk's](#) office beginning **Tuesday, October 11, 2022** through **Saturday, November 5, 2022**. Early Voting expands to alternate sites beginning on **Saturday, October 22, 2022** in many counties. On Election Day, polls will be open from **7:00am to 7:00pm**. You can find your [polling location](#) on the New Mexico Secretary of State website. Always be sure to bring your government ID with you. ***Don't delay, pledge to cast your vote during Early Voting and avoid the crowds.***

STEP 4

Celebrate Your Vote
