



# ArtsVote in Arizona

(Updated as of 7/17/22)

Ensure Your Vote is COUNTED on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 8, 2022

## CONFIRM

### Pre-Requisites

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be a resident of Arizona with your County listed on your registration
- Be at least 18 years of age by Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022
- Not be a convicted felon whose civil rights have not yet been restored
- Not be declared "adjudicated incapacitated" by a court

## STEP 1

### Register to Vote & Check Accuracy

Check the **Accuracy** of your [current voter registration](#) or **Register to Vote** for the first time [online](#), [in person](#), or [by mail](#) any time on or before **Tuesday, October 11**. If registering by mail, your registration must be POSTMARKED by **October 11** and RECEIVED by your local [County Recorder's Office](#) by **Election Day, November 8**. **Otherwise, you will not be able to vote on Election Day. Don't delay, pledge to check the accuracy of your voter status or register to vote by Tuesday, September 20, 2022.**

## STEP 2

### Request Your Absentee Ballot (If Preferred)

In Arizona, voting Ballot-By-Mail does **not require an excuse**, but you must apply for it because it will not be sent to you **automatically**. You can request a Ballot-By-Mail [online](#) or [by mail](#). The online or printed form must be RECEIVED by your [County Recorder's Office](#) by **Friday, October 28, 2022 at 5:00 pm**; otherwise, you have to physically vote in-person on Election Day. You can request to receive a Ballot-By-Mail beginning **early September**, but it must be RECEIVED by **Friday, October 28, 2022**. **Don't delay, pledge to request your absentee ballot by Tuesday, October 4, 2022.**

## STEP 3

### Cast Your Vote

**BALLOT-BY-MAIL:** You can return your Ballot-By-Mail one of three ways. 1) You can cast your vote by **mailing-in** your completed and SIGNED Ballot-By-Mail, which must be RECEIVED by [County Recorder's Office](#) by **Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022 at 7:00pm**. 2) You can take your ballot to one of the official county [ballot drop-off locations](#) by **Election Day, November 8 at 7:00 pm**. 3) You can take your ballot to any [voting location](#) by **Election Day, November 8, 2022 by 7:00pm**. You can track the status of your ballot using the [Arizona Absentee Tracker](#). **Don't delay, pledge to submit your completed Ballot-By-Mail by October 18, 2022.**

- OR -

**IN-PERSON VOTING:** Cast your vote **early-in-person** at your correct [polling place](#). Early Voting is open from **Wednesday, October 12, 2022** through **Friday, November 4, 2022 at 5:00 pm**. A list of early voting locations and their hours will become available closer to the General Election and can be found on your [County Recorder's Office](#). Voters can track the status of their early ballot using the [Absentee Tracker](#). If you prefer to vote on **Election Day**, polls are open from **6:00am to 7:00pm** at your correct [voting location](#). Always be sure to bring your government ID with you. **Don't delay, pledge to cast your vote during Early Voting and avoid the crowds.**

## STEP 4

### Celebrate Your Vote

**Celebrate** being an ArtsVote leader by posting a selfie of you mailing-in your ballot or wearing an "I Voted" sticker on social media.
