The U.S. Treasury Department released long-awaited **<u>guidance and the official application</u> for PPP loan forgiveness** on May 15, 2020.


Official guidance for the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) on how to get your loan forgiven and turned into a grant has been the burning question since the popular program launched in early April. In just the first round of funding, the Treasury Department reported that the Arts, Entertainment & Recreation sector was awarded more than \$4.9 billion in loans to 39,000+ organizations and gig workers.

Americans for the Arts and the Arts Action Fund will be scheduling a webinar very soon on these guidelines. In the meantime, I will be discussing this information during my Office Hours on Zoom tomorrow at 11:00am EST
